Internship

V. is looking for an **intern in the department of social responsibility for its office in Berlin from August 26th 2024**. In particular, the intern will support the preparation, follow-up and implementation of the Global Health Summer School [“Trauma, Empowerment and the Right to Health in an Era of Forced Displacement”](#) from September 20th to 27th.

About IPPNW Germany

IPPNW Germany was founded forty years ago as a federation of medical organisations for the prevention of nuclear war during the Cold War. Since then, the organisation has worked to avert threats to life and health by organising events, actions and campaigns, and promoting activism in the areas of nuclear disarmament and nuclear energy, peace and social responsibility.

Your tasks

- Administrative and organisational support of the project team
- Communication with global health summer school participants and speakers
- Assistance with the preparation of background materials
- Support of activities and events with the Kurdish-Turkish delegation from September 16th to 28th to Germany
- Follow-up after the summer school (accounting, reporting, management of the alumni network, etc.)
- General support for other IPPNW projects (i.e. Working group on refugees & asylum)

Duration: flexible, min. 8 weeks, with an expense allowance of 450€/month for mandatory internships

Your profile

- Knowledge of and/or interest in global health topics
- Very good written and spoken English, at least basic German
- Strong communication skills, intercultural competence and trauma-sensitivity
- Identification with the goals of IPPNW
- Initial experience in event management and a high sense of responsibility
- Good computer skills

If you do not have to complete a mandatory internship for your studies, you may receive an allowance for voluntary work (840€ in total).

If you are interested, we look forward to **receiving your application by June 30th** (short letter of motivation, CV without photo, if applicable, proof of a mandatory internship as part of your studies).
